OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY AND HEALTH (CLASSIFICATION, PACKAGING AND LABELLING
OF HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS) REGULATIONS 1997

Regulation 9. Duty of supplier to furnish Chemical Safety Data Sheet.

(1) A supplier shall furnish an up-to-date Chemical Safety Data Sheet for each hazardous chemical supplied.

(2) The Chemical Safety Data Sheet shall contain the following information:

- (a) the chemical product itself including the trade or common name of the chemical and the company identification with the details of the supplier;
- (b) the composition of the ingredients that clearly identifies the hazardous chemical for the purpose of conducting a hazard evaluation;
- (c) the hazard identification;
- (d) the first aid measures;
- (e) the fire fighting measures;
- (f) the accidental release measures;
- (g) the handling and storage;
- (h) the exposure controls and personal protection (including the possible methods of monitoring workplace exposure);
- (i) the physical and chemical properties;
- (j) the stability and reactivity;
- (k) the toxicological information (including the potential routes of entry into the body and the possibility of synergism with other chemicals or hazards encountered at work);
- (l) the ecological information;
- (m) the disposal information;
- (n) the transport information; and
- (o) the date of preparation of the Chemical Safety Data Sheet.

(3) The supplier shall review and revise the Chemical Safety Data Sheet from time to time when new information on a particular hazardous chemical becomes available.

(4) All information required on a Chemical Safety Data Sheet in pursuance of subregulation (2) shall be written in the national language and English.
